Concise. Reports should be brief but also contain all relevant information necessary for a complete understanding of the crime or incident, without additional explanation. Brevity should never take precedence over accuracy, completeness, or clarity in report writing. 5. Complete. A complete report will contain all the relevant facts, information, and details that the reader will need to have in order to have a comprehensive understanding of the crime or incident described in the report.
